Dear Parishioners,

Many people enjoy watching sports and cheer on their teams or favourite athletes. In doing so, they put forward a lot of effort. For the athletes who hear the cheers and screams, it helps to motivate them to perform as best as they can, knowing that they are supported by fans.

St Paul uses the analogy of a race to explain how we succeed in living out our faith. Like a runner who has both eyes on the finish line, we are racing towards Christ, who is our goal. The great cloud of witnesses are the Saints in heaven, but also the members of the Church on earth. The race is not against the other runners, but rather against ourselves: against self-doubt, selfishness, pride, apathy. Our focus on Christ puts all other concerns out of our minds, just as a runner thinks of nothing but crossing the finish line as fast as possible.

While a runner knows the length of the race, we do not know how long our lives will be; but compared to the eternity we are promised after this life, our time on earth is more like a sprint. While we run our race towards Christ and experience the support of the Saints in heaven, we also need to ask ourselves how well do we motivate and encourage our fellow racers towards the finish line.

BAPTISM

New and expectant parents are invited to contact the parish office to begin baptism preparation. Regular Sunday Mass attendance and a one-hour class are required before scheduling. The class can be taken before your child is born. Baptisms ordinarily take place after 10.00 am Sunday Mass.

Children aged 7 and up will need age-appropriate Catholic instruction before baptism. Please introduce yourself to Fr Ian after Mass for more details.

THE SACRAMENTS OF FIRST HOLY COMMUNION AND RECONCILIATION

To register your child for our First Holy Communion preparation classes, the following requirements must be met:

- The child must have already been baptised in the Catholic faith.
- •We will accept children of parents who are registered with and are practicing members of St Ann's Parish.
