Dear Parishioners,

We like to think that we know people and know everything about them. We want to know our family and friends to share a sense of intimacy and companionship with them. We like to know about our enemies and those who might do us harm or those whom we do not like so that we can feel superior to them or to protect ourselves from what they might do to us and those we love.

The (scary) reality is that we never know others fully. There is always a part of ourselves that we keep hidden from others, even those whom we love the most. Often we do not even fully understand these secret parts of ourselves.

Part of Christ's message in today's Gospel is reminding us that the outward appearance of those around us is not the way to tell who is holy and who is not. Only God knows what is in our hearts, the demons we have to battle, the difficulties we have in understanding and accepting the circumstances that we are in (or that we see others in).

Christ wants us to give others the benefit of the doubt. We have enough to worry about, and there is no need to be overburdened by comparing ourselves to others, but only encouraging all around us to follow Christ, most importantly by the examples we set.

BAPTISM

New and expectant parents are invited to contact the parish office to begin baptism preparation. Regular Sunday Mass attendance and a one-hour class are required before scheduling. The class can be taken before your child is born. Baptisms ordinarily take place after 10.00 am Sunday Mass.

Children aged 7 and up will need age-appropriate Catholic instruction before baptism. Please introduce yourself to Fr Ian after Mass for more details.

THE SACRAMENTS OF FIRST HOLY COMMUNION AND RECONCILIATION

To register your child for our First Holy Communion preparation classes, the following requirements must be met:

- The child must have already been baptised in the Catholic faith.
- •We will accept children of parents who are registered with and are practicing members of St Ann's Parish.
