Dear Parishioners,

In many churches where stained glass windows are on two levels, the Saints are on the higher level, while images from the life of Christ are on the lower. Christ came down to earth in order to raise us up to heaven. The statues and images of the Saints in our churches show us those men and women who have made it to heaven and give us examples of fully living out the Catholic faith.

When we come to Mass, we join them in praising God around His heavenly throne. The Letter to the Hebrews today reminds us of this fact. We are told that we have approached the New and Eternal Jerusalem, with all the angles and Saints.

There are many ways that this reality should affect us, but two points in particular:

- 1. We should be comforted by the fact that at Mass, where heaven meets earth, we are surrounded by the love of God, and the company of Saints who are supporting us. This includes those loved ones who have died, whom we firmly hope, and trust have been admitted into Heaven.
- 2. Our churches are not just buildings like any other. Our churches are sacred place, where we encounter God. Not only at Mass, but every moment of the day. We should take time to stop into churches and say a quick prayer or at least bow our heads or make the sign of the cross as we pass them in this way, we recognise God's presence ever in our midst, but especially where He becomes present in the Eucharist.

BAPTISM

New and expectant parents are invited to contact the parish office to begin baptism preparation. Regular Sunday Mass attendance and a one-hour class are required before scheduling. The class can be taken before your child is born. Baptisms ordinarily take place after 10.00 am Sunday Mass.

Children aged 7 and up will need age-appropriate Catholic instruction before baptism. Please introduce yourself to Fr Ian after Mass for more details.

THE SACRAMENTS OF FIRST HOLY COMMUNION AND RECONCILIATION

To register your child for our First Holy Communion preparation classes, the following requirements must be met:

- The child must have already been baptised in the Catholic faith.
- •We will accept children of parents who are registered with and are practicing members of St Ann's Parish.
