A Warm Welcome To All Our Parishioners and Visitors The Exaltation of the Holy Cross Sunday 14th September 2025



Dear Parishioners,

Today we celebrate the Feast of the Exultation of the Holy Cross. Two feasts used to be celebrated in connection with the relics of the Holy Cross. In May was the commemoration of the finding of the Holy Cross in Jerusalem by St Helen, the mother of the Emperor Constantine. Today's feast recalls the dedication of the basilica of the Holy Sepulchre in 335 and the return of the relics of the Holy Cross to Jerusalem in 628after they were taken by the Persian King.

The Cross is central to our faith. We wear crosses and hang them in our homes, we make the sign of the Cross to begin and end most prayers, we preach that we must take up our own crosses and recall how Christ died on the Cross for love of each of us. In the Cross we see both the Tree of Life and a weapon against sin and death.

On the Cross, Christ died to give us life. He offered himself, the first fruit of believers, and we are able to enjoy that fruit in the Eucharist as we consume His Body and Blood. Just as the fruit of a tree brought death to Adam and Eve, so Christ become the living fruit that gives life to all humanity. This is the meaning behind the medieval Christmas carol 'Jesus Christ, the Apple Tree.'

But the Cross is also a weapon. By the Cross, Christ defeated Satan and the devil's grasp on the world. Shaped like a sword, we can see in the Cross a way for us to defeat the temptations that assault us every day. Seeing the Cross or wearing the Cross is a way to recall Christ's power over evil, making the Sign of the Cross is our way of blessing ourselves and asking God to assist us in our daily struggles.

While we still are attacked by temptations and evil, we know that Christ has already won the victory over sin and death by His Death on the Cross. Our duty is to accept what He has done for us. The Cross is our only Hope, and today we exalt it as the instrument of our salvation.

BAPTISM

New and expectant parents are invited to contact the parish office to begin baptism preparation. Regular Sunday Mass attendance and a one-hour class are required before scheduling. The class can be taken before your child is born. **Baptisms ordinarily take place after 10.00 am Sunday Mass.**

Children aged 7 and up will need age-appropriate Catholic instruction before baptism. Please introduce yourself to Fr Ian after Mass for more details.

THE SACRAMENTS OF FIRST HOLY COMMUNION AND RECONCILIATION

To register your child for our First Holy Communion preparation classes, the following requirements must be met:

- The child must have already been baptised in the Catholic faith.
