Dear parishioners,

Power, love, and self-control.

St Paul in today's second reading tells St Timothy to 'fan into a flame the gift of God'. This gift, which was received by all who have been confirmed, needs our attention and care to reach its full potential. We cannot sit back and be passive to the workings of the Holy Spirit.

In particular, St Paul says that the Spirit of God helps us to have power, love, and self-control. Having power is connected to virtue and being able to grow in virtues and those good habits that show others that we are Christians. Love is the reason we practice and grow in these virtues: it is because of our love for God and neighbour that we want to do good in the world and help others know the dignity that is theirs. Self-control then allows us to increase in discipline - this helps us to focus no longer on ourselves and our selfish desires and motives, but rather to think outside ourselves and help us grow in true love.

However we do it, each of us has the responsibility to put in the hard work and make sure that Spirit of God in us does not go to waste. This week, pray for the wisdom to know what you need to do, and the grace and strength to do what needs to be done.

BAPTISM

New and expectant parents are invited to contact the parish office to begin baptism preparation. Regular Sunday Mass attendance and a one-hour class are required before scheduling. The class can be taken before your child is born. Baptisms ordinarily take place after 10.00 am Sunday Mass.

Children aged 7 and up will need age-appropriate Catholic instruction before baptism. Please introduce yourself to Fr Ian after Mass for more details.

THE SACRAMENTS OF FIRST HOLY COMMUNION AND RECONCILIATION

To register your child for our First Holy Communion preparation classes, the following requirements must be met: The child must have already been baptised in the Catholic faith. •We will accept children of parents who are registered with and are practicing members of St Ann's Parish.
