

#### Dear Parishioners,

Today's first and second readings indicate the importance of humility. The Lord comes to judge the proud and the evildoers. Pride is a great vice that tricks us to believe that we are something that we are not. Pride convinces us that we are better than we are, and that others are not as good as we are. Evil then is the result of pride, because when we think we are better than others, we treat others with a lack of kindness and respect. This is why St Paul is quick to assert that he has never wanted to place a burden on or take anything from the people to whom he preaches that was not freely given.

This is also reflected in the Gospel. Christ tells us that in the time of tribulations He will give us the words to speak. The proud will think that they can speak on their own and that their own wisdom is enough to win arguments against those who judge them; but the reality is that only the wisdom of Christ and our humility can serve to justify us and our faith.

We need to always be humble. Whether in our actions towards others or the way we speak and defend our faith, we need to remember that we are frail human beings who need God's grace as much as the next person. With that in mind we find it easier to judge others less, to treat others more kindly, and stay away from the evils that come with pride.

#### **BAPTISM**

New and expectant parents are invited to contact the parish office to begin baptism preparation. Regular Sunday Mass attendance and a one-hour class are required before scheduling. The class can be taken before your child is born. Baptisms ordinarily take place after 10.00 am Sunday Mass.

Children aged 7 and up will need age-appropriate Catholic instruction before baptism. Please introduce yourself to Fr Ian after Mass for more details.

## THE SACRAMENTS OF FIRST HOLY COMMUNION AND RECONCILIATION

To register your child for our First Holy Communion preparation classes, the following requirements must be met: • The child must have already been baptised in the Catholic faith. • We will accept children of parents who are registered with and are practicing members of St Ann's Parish.
